The Yarmouth Shark Scramble is a non-profit fishing tournament where teams compete to catch the largest weight of a single shark. The event is used as a fundraiser for local charities, with all catch information reported to the Department of Fisheries and Oceans for scientific research.

In 2019 we had 15 vessels with 127 participants.

Yarmouth Shark Scramble gained international attention in 2004 when the vessel Pembroke Princess landed one of the biggest Shortfin Mako Sharks on the planet and setting a Canadian record with his proud 1082 lb catch. This shark is featured on the main page of our website. We will also be unveiling our live replica of this shark, this summer during the tournament.
